TASTING NOTES— This bright, complex and lively wine is a cuvée blend of 8 different picks of Sauvignon Blanc from three different cool-climate vineyards. The individual wine lots were then blended together to produce this single varietal wine. Notes of guava, grapefruit and fresh asparagus works well paired with fresh BC salads, seafood and oysters.
